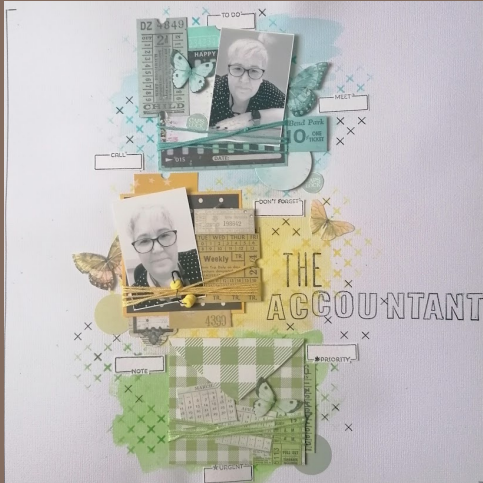

Ann- Layout 1

Ann grabbed some coordinating inks for a little water colour behind her 3 coloured blocks in her first layout here. You can chose other colours from the kit if you decide to lift this one which has none of the pink or purple.



Ann - Layout 2

Using the fabulous films strip to house her photos the remainder of this second layout from Ann was centred around the circle stickers which she stamped, doodled and layered to tie in with her photos and other elements from the kit used on the page.



Michelle - Layout 1

Inspired by a sketch which Michelle will share in our Facebook group she once again demonstrates how, with some clever placement, you can make your 6x4 patterned papers look alot bigger and those butterflies!!! We love them!



Michelle - Layout 2

Whilst Ann layered her blocks for her first layout Michelle keeps them simple but uses the more patterned papers here in a grid variation page which looks lovely on teh soft blue background. It also features more of those lovely butterflies!



Michelle - Layout 3

A mist of blue ink on a soft grey background starts off Michelle's 3rd layout this month with a stitched circle and a trio of mini embellishment clusters based on the lovely circle stickers in the box.



Tracy - Layout 1

The circle stickers inspired a full of circles page for Tracy's cute Pixie Girl layout. Layering circle punched papers in a variety of sizes with a circular photo and the stickers makes for an eyecatching layout.



Tracy - Layout 2

Tracy's second layout features lots of layering and perfectly demonstrates how to use up the last of your box to create clusters. The scattering of enamel dots from the box this month soften the lines of this clean page as do the punched hearts.
