Michelle - Layout 1

Using the negative letters from the HAPPY cut file as her title with some doodled stitch marks Michelle has made a beautiful wreath design. This uses the lovely leaves in the kit (vary designs per box) but everyone got all the colours.



Michelle - Layout 2

A bold use of the block sides of the papers makes for a striking rainbow row of chevrons on Michelle's second page. Of course she beings some stitching in on a great layout which captures the great British weather well!



Ann - Layout 1

Ann backed the cut file in an assortment of colours and then layered it over a stencilled rainbow background. She used several different stencils and matched the colours behind the letters and even her Morph hunt photos tie in colourwise too!



Ann - Layout 2

Ann's second pages picks just two of the colours and combines them with the black and white elements in the kit to get a completely different vibe. Swap out the blue and green for other colours to match your photo and use coloured ink to stamp a title.
